Figure 1. Concentration of total phosphorus for all production and bird types between from 2012 to 2016




Figure 2. Concentration of total nitrogen for all production and bird types between from 2012 to 2016




Figure 3. Concentration of ammonia nitrogen for all production and bird types between from 2012 to 2016




Figure 4. Concentration of potassium for all production and bird types between from 2012 to 2016




Figure 5. Moisture content of litter from all production and bird types between from 2012 to 2016



